Applicant is requesting a Variance from Sections 285-27.A. Building Setbacks.

The applicant was represented by Johnathan Hofstetter from Blakinger & Thomas Law Firm.

The Board heard testimony from the Applicant, Dale R Hershey.

The applicant is requesting a Dimensional Variance in order to build a front porch or their existing home. The proposed porch will extend 7 feet from the existing house, and will encroach 2 feet further into the front yard setback area than the existing front door stoop to be replaced. The Variance requested is de minimis, and will enhance the visual and aesthetic appeal of the property and will not alter the character of the surrounding neighborhood.
