

**WEST LAMPETER TOWNSHIP
PARK & RECREATION BOARD**

REGULAR MEETING
March 1, 2017

CALL TO ORDER - 7:30 pm. In attendance were members Claire Chivington, Carol Good, Dustin Knarr and Suzanne Ranck. Also present were Township Manager DeeDee McGuire and Board Supervisor Robert Patterson.

MINUTES -Suzanne Ranck motioned that they be accepted, Dustin Knarr seconded. Accepted 4-0

PARK LAND AT MAIN STREET - Dan Lake and Audrey Stinson, Willow Street Lions Club were present to talk about the park land at Main Street. Dan Lake felt that planning is very important. He'd like to know what is needed for the park to help facilitate development. Dan presented a "preliminary" plan. The question was brought up regarding Stormwater management. Audrey also mentioned putting an Interactive "green" space as an option. Audrey and Dan would like some ideas and feedback from the Parks & Recreation Board. The Lions Club wants to spearhead this and get this started. They were invited to come back next month so that we can give them some feedback/suggestions.

PUBLIC INPUT PERIOD - none

PARK UPDATES - The Feasibility Study has been done and was handed out to the Parks & Recreation Board for review. Highlights - there is in enthusiasm in the community for improvements and for the Village Park project. There is a determination that \$2.5mm is more aggressive and that the realistic number was \$1mm. They felt that we will need to revise the scope of the project. The conclusion was get the land done - get the dirt moved, provide portable lighting and if possible, restrooms. Supervisor Patterson stated that he came away from the meeting realizing that safety was important - from lighting to ground safety. The Parks & Recreation Board recommended that this be presented to the Board of Supervisors to pursue.
