PARK & RECREATION BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
July 6, 2022

CALL TO ORDER- 7:02pm. In attendance were members Dustin Knarr, Suzanne Ranck, Kevin Turner and Lauren Herr, as well as Township Manager Dee Dee McGuire.

MINUTES- June meeting minutes were voted on. Suzanne Ranck made a motion to approve. Lauren Herr seconded the motion.

PUBLIC INPUT PERIOD-None

Three community members were present- Geoff Beers, Craig Smith and Amanda Hickman.

VILLAGE PARK UPDATE- Scouts are looking to complete a community project. Some projects were discussed such as a chess table and possible library or book exchange cupboard. Dee Dee will pass along the suggestions to the scouts. The Desmond and Burton plaques will be installed in the next few days at Village Park. The monument is to be completed by September 1st, 2022.

SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT PLANS- Craig Smith presented at the meeting with the proposed plans for the Southpoint Community at Willow Valley. This expansion project will have nine new cottages with additional parking and updates to the existing house on the property. He displayed the plans for the committee to see and proposed all of the new recreational activities this property will have including pickleball courts, bocce ball courts, patio, firepit and a pavilion. The committee voted on recommending a \$15,300 in lieu of (\$1700 per unit) as a recreational fee to be approved by the Board of Supervisors. Kevin motioned to agree and Suzanne seconded the motion.

PARK UPDATES- Amanda shared that the preliminary plan for the Willow Street Park should arrive by next week with the updated changes.

PARK ENRICHMENT- Movie night was a great success. There was a very good turnout with close to 200 people. Vendors did well and there was positive feedback from attendees. The ladies from Penn State did a great job and the balloon artists were kept busy all evening.

The only complaint was for a closer bathroom which Dee Dee suggested renting a porta potty to put at a closer location for next year. The consensus was to have movie night again around the same time next year in 2023. Special thanks to Jim Kreider for all of his work, as well as Dee Dee and Amanda for their detail and prep work leading up to the event.

ADJOURNMENT- Suzanne Ranck motioned for the meeting to be adjourned at 7:22 pm. Lauren Herr seconded the motion. All approved and the meeting was adjourned.
